Invitation to participate

The Mahatma Gandhi Institute is organising the 36th Salon de Mai from 31st May to 10th June 2017. Artists of the Republic of Mauritius are invited to participate. The proposed theme is *Difference and Repetition*.

A concept note for the 2017 Salon de Mai, and artist's application form is available on the mgi website: www.mgirti.org.

Criteria for participation

1. Participants should be of Mauritian nationality and should :

- have undergone a minimum of 3 years study from a recognized Art Institution

OR

- have ten years' experience in the field

OR

- have hosted at least solo or group exhibitions

OR

- be regular practising artists

2. All artworks should be original and should have been executed within the previous two years.

3. Outdoor installations can be only be made of recycled materials and **will not** be insured.

4. Wherever any specific display is requested by the participant, s/he must utilize his/her materials and all relevant information must be given in the participation form.

5. A panel will be responsible for the selection of the artworks. The decision of the panel will be final and without appeal. Only one work, if selected, will be displayed.
6. Participants will be responsible for the transportation of the entries to and from the venue. The works of art retained for the exhibition shall be dismantled/ taken away within a week after the closing date of the exhibition.
7. The Mahatma Gandhi Institute will communicate their choice of *in-situ* installations and other site- specific work, but the panel reserves the right to allocate space.
8. Artworks displayed inside the gallery will be covered by a nominal insurance during the exhibition. Works not collected within a week after the closing date of the exhibition will not be covered by insurance and the Mahatma Gandhi Institute will not be liable for any loss and/or damage of the exhibit.
9. The Mahatma Gandhi Institute reserves the right to reproduce the selected materials for advertising and promotional purposes.
10. A levy of 15% will be retained on any sold work.
